

229. *MIRABILIS MULTIFLORA* (Torr. Gray (NYCTAGINACEAE) — Soksi

Hopi medicine men chew on the roots to enable them to render visionary diagnoses of their patients' diseases.<sup>54</sup>

Reported to be hallucinogenic, soksi is a folk remedy for stomachache.<sup>32</sup> Hopi Indians use the roots for stomach ailments.<sup>54</sup>

**Toxicity** — Narcotic hallucinogen.<sup>54</sup>
