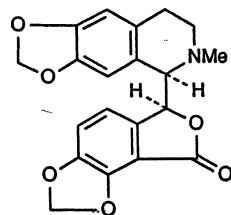
Corynoline (49-32): R = H
Acetylcorynoline (49-33): R = Ac



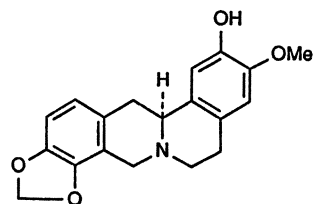
Corlumidine (49-34)



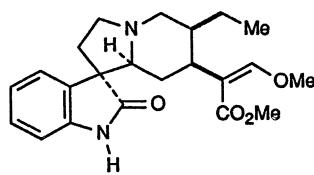

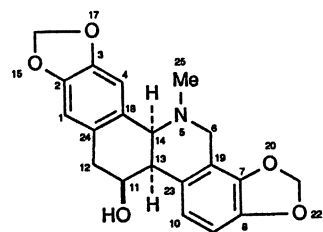

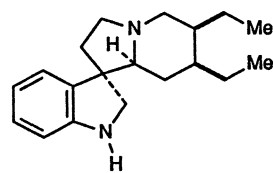

Corydalis bungeana is a folk medicine used as an antipyrogenic and an antiinflammatory agent. From the above-ground part of *C. bungeana*, the alkaloids protopine, isocorynoline (49-41), acetylisocorynoline, corynoline, tetrahydrocoptisine, acetylcorynoline, tetrahydrocorysamine (49-42), and 11-epicorynoline were isolated and identified [28–31].
